

Circular Needle Clutch

Craft Leftovers

Ingredients:

- 1 fat quarter piece of fabric main color
- 1 fat quarter piece of fabric contrasting color
- 3 yards bias tape made from contrasting colored fabric
- Button
- Straight pins
- Scissors
- Sewing machine
- Favorite Circular Needles!



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Directions:

1. Cut all pieces from template for main color as shown in figure 1.

Cut #4 from contrasting color as well.

Use the rest of contrasting fabric to make your bias tape.

3. Sew bias tape along the top of #2 and #3 and the bottom of #1 (fig. 2 and 3).

4. Pin #2 and #3 to #4 of the contrasting color so that #2 and #3 line up with the bottom and #1 lines up with the top. Use a loose straight stitch to secure them together. Mark off 3 3/4 inches and 7 1/2" from the straight side on the right (fig 2 and 3).

Straight stitch vertical lines to make the slots for the circular needles (fig. 2)

5. Pin fabric pieces together with #4 main color on the bottom with the right side facing down and the 1/2/3/4 piece right side facing up. Use a long straight stitch to secure them together.

6. Pin on and stitch bias tape around the edges (fig 4).



7. Make a button hole in the flap.

8. Sew the button on so it lines up with the button hole.

Voila! Fini!
