

# *I ♥ Felting*

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## Craft Leftovers

### Ingredients:

4oz of various bulky feltable wool such as Lamb's Pride  
Bulky or Kreamer's Mauch Chunky  
US size 10 1/2 24" circular needles  
1" button or larger  
Sewing needle and thread  
Sharp scissors



Directions:

CO 15

Work garter stitch for 10", approx 25 garter ridges (50 rows).

Pick up and knit the sts on the 3 sides of the base. Pickup between the garter ridges on the long side (25 sts), the cast on stitch (15 sts), and the other long side (25 sts).

80 sts now on the needles.

Join in the round and knit 40 rounds in stockenette stitch.

Bind off all stitches.

Weave in all ends and felt by running through a hot wash cold rinse, twice if needed, and let air dry.

I formed mine with folds on the sides and put cookie sheet with a big heavy book on it to weigh it down.

Find the middle of your front side and cut a hole for your button.

Line up and sew on your button so it matches the hole on the other side.

If you have multiple small balls of yarn and not just one color, this is the striping pattern that I used for three colors (MC, CC1, CC2)

Bottom CC2

In the round:

18 rounds MC

5 rnds CC1

1 rnd MC

2 rnds CC1

8 rnds CC2

2 rnds CC1

1 rnd MC

6 rnds CC1
