

The Perfect Dishcloth

Craft Leftovers

Ingredients:

2 balls of yarn - 1 1/2 oz each color

MC: Undyed feltable undyed wool

CC: Any kitchen cotton worsted weight

Crochet Hook size G (4.5 mm)

Abbreviations:

Sdc – spike double crochet –work dc over ch sp by inserting hook into top of next row below (or base chain).

Dc – double crochet

Ch - chain

Sc - single crochet

Sl - Slip Stitch

St(s) - Stitch(es)

Rep - Repeat

Notes:

Change colors every 3rd row, carry yarn up the side along the turn chain.

Directions:

Chain 29

Row 1: Skip 3ch, counts as first double crochet, 1 dc into each of next 2ch, *ch3, skip ch3, 1dc into each of next ch3. Rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: *ch3, skip 3 sts, 1 sdc over each of next 3 sts; rep from * to last3 sts, ch2, skip 2sts, slst into top of tch, turn.

Row 3: ch3, skip 1 st, 1sdcover each of next 2 sts, *ch3 ,skip 3 sts, 1 sdc over each of next 3 sts; repfrom * to end, turn.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 - 7 times.

To finish:

Repeat row 2

Last Row: Ch 1, sc3, *1 sdc over each of next 3 sts, sc3;* Rep from * * to end.

Sc into each st place around all sides of the dish cloth. Working 3 sc sts into the same st at the four corners. Cut yarn and pull through loop. Weave in all ends.

To felt you can either just use the dish cloth as is and it will felt up after a few loads of dishes. You can also just throw it into the washer with your towels and that will felt it up as well.
