Ingredients:

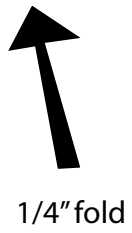
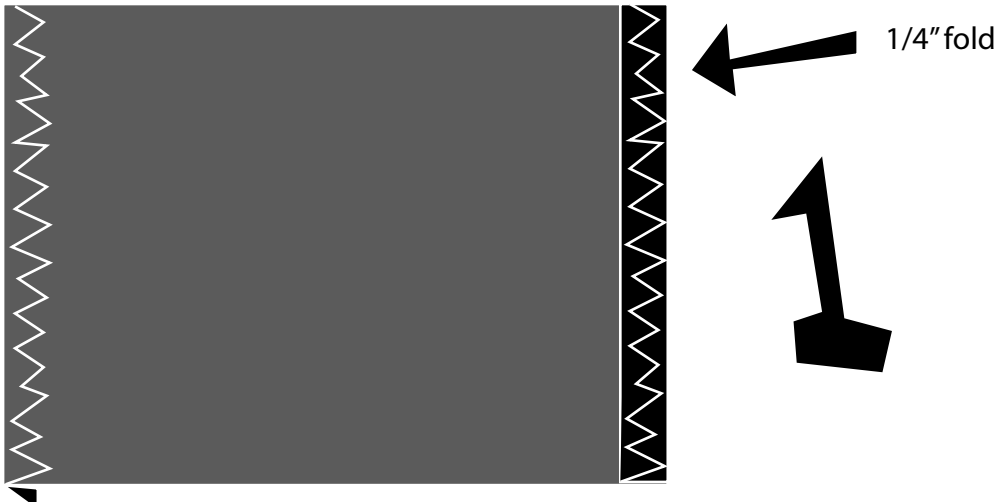
- 2 pieces of fabric 9" x 6.5"
- Any embellishments desired - buttons or a little rick rack would be nice
- Tissues to fill it with

Directions:

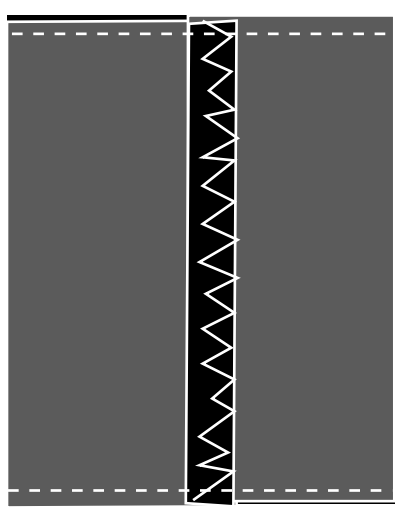
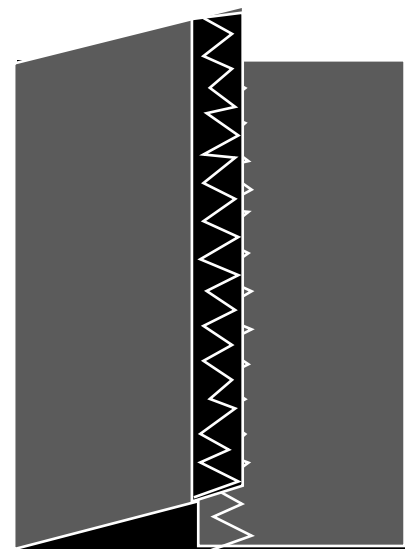
1. Cut two pieces of contrasting fabric 9" x 6.5"
2. Place fabric together, right sides facing. Straight stitch 1/4" around edges, leaving a 3" gap.
3. Turn right sides out, stitch up gap and iron flat.
4. Fold and press short edges in opposite directions. Use zigzag stitch to tack in place (fig 1).
5. Fold fabric together so that way the folded edges over-lap in the center (fig 2). Stitch sides up (fig 3).

You are now the proud maker of a travel tissue holder! Enjoy and don't sneeze too much this winter!
